AID & ATTENDANCE AND/OR HOUSEBOUND PROGRAM

Welcome to the Aid & Attendance Program through the Veterans Service Office. A veteran or widow will be considered to be in need of regular aid and attendance if he or she is at home or a patient in a nursing home or assisted living facility, or is helpless or blind and requires the regular aid and attendance of another person.

QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE:

- Veteran must have served in the military for 90 consecutive days with one day during qualifying wartime.
- Have less than \$80,000 in assets (not including home, car, etc.).
- Veteran or surviving spouse needs assisted living, skilled nursing or is housebound.
- Income less than \$1049 per month, after medical expenses, medicines, health insurance premiums, etc.

Follows are the steps that need to be taken to file an accurate claim with the Department of Veterans Affairs on your behalf.

- ***PHYSICIAN'S REPORT*** - Have your physician fill out the enclosed physician's report
- ***MEDICAL EXPENSE REPORT*** - Please fill out
- ***INCOME REPORT*** - Please fill out
- ***ASSISTED LIVING/NURSING HOME VA Form 21-0779*** (If applicable)
- ***IN HOME CARE PROVIDER LETTER OF SERVICES*** (If applicable)

Return all of the above documentation completed with the following:

If filing for a veteran only:

- Discharge Papers (DD-214)

If filing for a veteran and his spouse:

- Discharge Papers (DD-214)
- Marriage Certificate

If filing for the surviving spouse of a veteran:

- Discharge Papers (DD-214)
- Marriage Certificate
- Death Certificate of Veteran
